

Reception Curriculum News Spring 1 2025



Our topic is 'People who help us'. We will be learning about all the different people and job roles who help us. Our stories with be focusing on different jobs and helping those around us.

Personal Social Emotional Development

In My happy mind our focus this term is appreciation. We are looking at all the things we are grateful for and how we can show we are thankful.

In our Jigsaw PSHE lessons we will be focusing on our dreams and goals and how we can achieve these even when something may be challenging.

Communication, Language and Literacy

During this term we will encourage children to use full sentences when talking.

As part of our 'People who Help us' topic, children will be encouraged to discuss their experiences of people that may help us in our community and in our families.

Children are continually learning letter sounds and are encouraged to read their DI sheets at home. We are working on using our phonic knowledge to write words and sentences.

Mathematics

We will be looking at numbers 0-8. How to compose these numbers, write these numbers and what is one more and one less than a number.

Understanding the World

This term we will be talking about people in our community, such as delivery and shop staff, hairdressers, the police, the fire service, nurses, doctors and teachers.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring different techniques and using a variety of materials to create portraits, collages and junk models of people that help us and their vehicles.
