English

In our writing lessons this half term we will learn to write a report to inform the reader about the importance of eating and doing regular exercise to help us to keep healthy.

We will continue to learn how to form complete, correctly punctuated sentences when we write a narrative whilst also continuing to practise using inverted commas for direct speech.

We will look at homophones and practise spelling Y3/Y4 words as recommended by the national curriculum.

Maths

This half term we will look at multiplication and division facts for 3, 4, 8 multiplication tables. We will multiply a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.

In arithmetic, we are focusing on our times tables. So far, we have been practising our 2,3,5,and 10s. We will begin learning our 6s and use our 3 times table to help us with that. We are also looking at how to add and subtract fractions and also how to multiply simple fractions.

Topic – Animals (including humans) and Diet

We will begin this topic by learning about the different types of nutrition and the importance of eating the right types of nutrition to stay healthy. We will continue on to understand the differences in teeth and how digestion occurs. We will also look at the different functions of the skeleton and muscles.

PΕ

In PE, we are learning how to move with control in time to the music. We will perform dance movements showing travelling in different directions e.g. sliding, turning, gesturing.

Art/DT

In art this term we will be learning about using clay to make a sculpture. we will construct a base for extending and modelling other shapes. We will learn about how to produce more intricate surface patterns and textures, using them appropriately in our model.
