English

This half term we will be writing a story based on The Nowhere Emporium and a non-fiction text about Anglo-Saxons.

Children will look at the features of these texts and learn and how to write complex sentences that are correctly punctuated.

In Reading, we will be focusing on core skills and finding the answers in the text. We will be reading a range of texts that are linked to our topic of Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

Maths

This half term we will be continuing to work on calculations.

Children will:

- Convert mixed numbers and improper fractions
- Order and compare fractions
- Add and subtract fractions with different denominators
- Read and write decimal numbers as fractions

We will also continue to practice using the four operations in arithmetic.

Topic

Our History topic this half term will be 'Anglo-Saxons and Vikings' and we will be learning whether the Saxon times were really the Dark Ages. We will have a Saxon visitor coming in, and we will learn how to do lots of crafts and art. We will learn lots about the beginnings of England as a country and why people wanted to come here. We will find out lots about famous battles and what impact the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings had on this country.

PE

Children will be learning how to play 'Quick Sticks', a version of hockey. They will learn how to control the ball and work as a team to pass and tackle. They will also be learning how to do jumps, tucks and rolls in Gymnastics

Art/ DT

This half term, children will learn about sewing and use a variety of stitches to make our own Viking coin purses that are decorated with hand stitched runes.

Reminders

- ✓ All children should read for 20 minutes every night and should bring their reading book each day.
- ✓ Homework is given out on a Wednesday and is handed in on the following Monday
- ✓ Creative homework pieces can be brought in at any time
- ✓ PE Kits are needed on Tuesdays, but may be worn every day for Active learning
